Our History

The history of the oldest and largest university in Crimea dates back to 1918 when the first institution of tertiary education, Taurida University, was established in the peninsula. Among its notable founders were prominent Russian scientists Vladimir Vernadsky, Roman Helwig, Nikolai Andrusov, Mikhail Bogoslovsky, Vladimir Obruchev, and Vladimir Palladin.

Even though the number one university in Crimea has born different names over the years, its core values have remained the same since it was established: high-quality education and outstanding research.













The University Today

Today, V.I. Vernadsky Crimean Federal University is the top university in Crimea with a well-established reputation for teaching and research excellence that spans more than 100 years.

The Academy has over 40 departments and offers programmes in:




